

# 12 Days of Christmas

## Fundraising ideas for KSS



### 1 Festive fivers

Ask everyone to bring a £5 note. Write your name on a post-it note and stick it to your fiver, pop them into a hat and pick a winner. Then split the pot between the lucky winner and KSS.

It costs KSS £16.6m each year to keep flying and saving lives

### 2 Karaoke carols

Belt out your favourite festive tunes by hosting a Christmas karaoke competition with each participant donating to KSS to take part. Judges can then decide who put on the best seasonal performance.

### 3 Cash not cards

Agree not to send cards to each other, your family and friends and instead, donate what you would spend.

On Christmas Day last year, we attended to eight patients who were critically ill or injured

### 4 Secret Santa

Instead of having a £5 or £10 Secret Santa budget, ask those taking part to set a limit of £4 or £9 instead, with everyone donating the spare £1 to KSS

We are working harder than ever to put an end to preventable loss of life

### 5 Festive foody fun

Bake them, buy them, sell them and enjoy them. Whether its mince pies, cheese straws, Christmas puddings or chutney, why not hold a festive bake sale?

Just £1 can buy bubble wrap to prevent a patient from hypothermia

### 6 Guess the angel

How angelic were your colleagues or group members as babies? Bring in a Christmas baby photo, have them on display for all your colleagues to guess who they are for a donation.

It costs £45K per day to operate our lifesaving service.

### 7 Christmas hamper raffle

Have you got a local farm shop that could supply you with a Christmas hamper to raffle off in the office?

Our crew are able to administer blood transfusions at the roadside, preventing a patient from bleeding to death

### 8 Wrap party

Wrapping presents can take a lot of time and energy. Ask for volunteers to wrap presents for those that get tangled in tape doing so, in exchange for a donation to KSS.

£6 could buy a child's bag-valve-mask to help resuscitate a critically ill or injured child

### 9 Christmas quiz

£13 could buy a unit of blood for a critically injured patient

### 10 Christmas crafting

Get together with colleagues, group members or family to make a tree decoration, Christmas wreath or maybe even a gingerbread house.

£22 could buy a Tracheal Hook used to surgically open a patients throat to create an airway

### 11 Christmas hat competition

Design and make a Christmas hat, have them judged blind and select a winner. You could even arrange a hat parade. Donate to enter.

### 12 Festive dress-up

Wear your most festive outfit to work or at your next meeting. This could include Christmas ties, socks and head boppers to make it extra festive and donate for the privilege.
